



MARION (MURPHY) SIMSER

July 16, 1921 - March 29, 2021

Marion A. Simser, age 99, of La Crescent, died March 29, 2021, at SpringBrook Village.

Funeral services will be held Friday, April 9, 2021, at 11:00 AM at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Caledonia, MN. Visitation will be from 4 PM -7PM on Thursday, April 8th and Friday, April 9th from 10:00 – 11:00 AM at St. Mary's Catholic Church. Burial will be at Calvary Cemetery in Blue Earth, MN on Saturday, April 10th at 11:00 AM.

Marion was born July 16, 1921 at Oak Park, MN, the daughter of Anna Legler and William Peulen. She married Floyd Murphy, January 4, 1944 at Newport, Arkansas. Floyd proceeded her in death, June 4th, 1979. She married Kenneth Simser, May 5th, 1984 and he proceeded her in death May 13th, 1999. Marion retired from U.S. Bank at the age of 75 and worked as the church secretary at SS Peters and Paul Church in Blue Earth until she retired at age 87. She moved to Caledonia, MN to be closer to family in 2009 where she was embraced by the community.

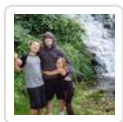
