Christina Viehauser, 62, was welcomed into eternity by her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and His Blessed Mother on Dec. 1, 2024, after a short valiant fight with cancer. She died peacefully in the presence of her fiancée, Christopher Von Arx, and three of her five beloved children.

Christina was born in Munich Germany and moved to the United States with her parents David and Erika Sorum when she was just an infant.

As a child, she developed a true love for horses, as she would ride them with her very best friend every day. As many know, this love for horses carried on throughout her life, as she found so much peace and solace in their presence.

Christina was a mother of five children, four daughters and one son. Her love for her children was unconditional. She not only taught, but was a genuine model of maternal strength, kindness, amazing work ethic, integrity, grace, and compassion for those around her. She loved joy and was well known for laughing so hard she cried.
