Dan Kirkpatrick 63, of Freeburg, Minn. died unexpectedly at his home on Thursday, December 3rd, 2015.

Dan was born November 1st 1952 in Arlington, Va. to John & Wanda Kirkpatrick. He entered the U.S. Army in 1971 after high school in McLean, Va. He served as a door gunner with the 57th Attack Helicopter Outfit. He was wounded during combat and awarded the Nations Purple Heart. He was also awarded a Bronze Star with "V" for valor for heroic actions while under enemy fire.
