David H. Schmitz passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on December 31, 2023 at the age of 81 years.

After high school, David worked for the Houston County Highway Department. He joined the army on July 15, 1964 and proudly served until July 2, 1966. While in the army David earned the Sharpshooter Award, the Good Conduct Medal, and the National Defense Service Medal. Upon returning home from the army, David returned to work at the highway department.

On June 24th, 1967, David married Rita Thimmesch and they had 5 wonderful children. They later divorced.

In 1990, David met the love of his life, Betty Paus. They were married on July 23, 1993. David & Betty just celebrated 30 years of marriage.

David dedicated 37 years of his career to the Houston County Highway

Department. Following his retirement, he continued working part-time for Kruckow Rock Products, where he maintained township roads for another 20 years.

David was a hardworking husband, father, and grandfather. He found joy in spending time in his woodshop, feeding the birds, and watching football, particularly the Minnesota Vikings. David enjoyed watching classic TV shows like The Three Stooges and old Westerns with his loyal dog, Bear. David spent his free time with his family and grandchildren, playing cards, and taking drives in the countryside.
