Evelyn C (Greisch) Wagner, 94, of Caledonia died Monday, Oct. 18, 2010 at Dove Healthcare in Eau Claire, WI. Born April 15, 1916 to Joseph and Susie (Longueville) Greisch, Evelyn was a native of Caledonia and a life-long member of St. Mary's Parish.

After graduating from Loretto High School in 1933, Evelyn worked in the local theater and then as a telephone operator. She married Earl E. Wagner on January 29, 1942.

Evelyn was an avid reader, a talented seamstress and tailor. Her embroidery work was exceptional. Evelyn often entered her sewing projects in competition at the county fair, never bringing home less than a blue ribbon. She took pride in her skill as a loving wife and mother, homemaker, cook and gardener.

She also leaves behind 16 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.

Evelyn was preceded in death by her parents, half-sisters Ivona Burg and
