Genevieve Marie (Klinkhammer) Molling, Age 89, Caledonia, MN died on October 30, 2013. She was born November 16, 1923 at Miner, ND to John and Josephine (Goergen) Klinkhammer. She married Lloyd Molling June 21, 1950 at St. John The Baptist Catholic Church, Caledonia, MN. She graduated from Lemmon High School, Lemmon, SD in 1941. She received her teacher's certificate from Presentation College in Mitchel, SD and a B.S. Degree from Winona State College, Winona, MN. She taught school in South Dakota for five years before coming to Minnesota where she taught for many years at the Caledonia Public School and at St. Mary's Elementary School.

Genevieve and her husband farmed and raised their family in Mayville Township until they moved to town in 1980. Genevieve loved and enjoyed her family, grandchildren and great-grandchildren and liked to read, travel, sing, garden, sew, work crossword puzzles, play scrabble and cards. She was a member of St. Mary's Parish and it's Council of Catholic Women, Catholic Daughters of the Americas and a long time member of the church choir.
