



## MARVIN M. ROLLINS

August 3, 1926 - January 5, 2011

Marvin M. Rollins, 84, of Cresco, formerly of Caledonia, died Wednesday, January 5, 2011 at Patty Elwood Center in Cresco.

He was born August 3, 1926 in Menomonee, WI to Charles and Grace (Wheaton) Rollins. He served in the U.S. Navy as a boiler tender from 1944-46 in the southeast Pacific. Marvin worked most of his life as a draftsman for Minneapolis Moline and John Deere. He lived in Cedar Falls, IA, Hot Springs, AR, and Cresco.
