Early in the morning of Monday of March 30th Richard Leo Wagner, loving husband and father of two children passed away at the age of 66.

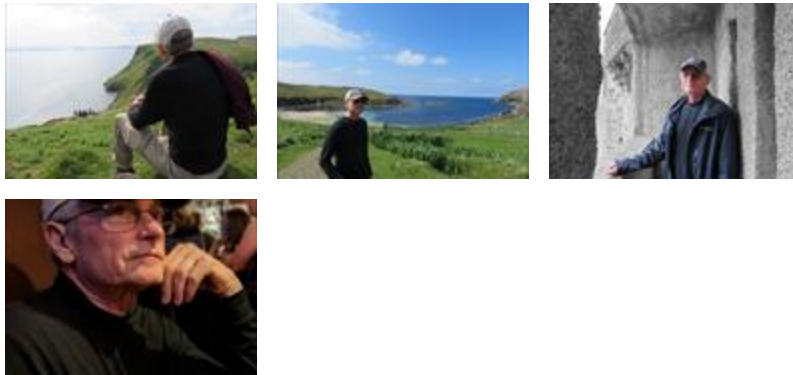
