Thomas "Tom" H. Bechtel, age 90, of Caledonia, passed away on June 3, 2025

Tom was born January 14, 1935, in Lansing, Iowa, son of Theodore and Harriet (Peterson) Bechtel.

Tom graduated from high school in 1950. He served in the United States Army in Korea in 1955, until he was honorably discharged in 1957. He married Mary Whalen on June 17, 1961, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church, New Albin, Iowa.

Tom, along with his wife raised 8 children, on their farm, in Minnesota, near New Albin, and other farms in Lansing, Iowa.
