



## VIRGINA ANN (SCHROEDER) HUGHES

Virginia Ann (Schroeder) Hughes passed away Saturday, October 25th, in her Caledonia home, surrounded by family. In her final days she was at peace and spoke often about her faith and her love for her family.

Virginia was born October 2nd, 1930, in Ann Arbor, Michigan, and grew up an only child to parents Dr. Henry and Gladys Duiker. She attended two years of college at the University of Chicago and Bradley University, where she met Donald Schroeder.
